- Technology Consulting Program
- Washington DC (virtually this summer)
 - Lots of offices around the country
- July 6 - August 7
 - Normally June 2-August 3
- Paid internship
- Different branches
 - Risk
 - Financial Services
 - Audit
 - Consulting (business & technology)

Program Structure

- One week training
- 3 weeks working on a team with a client
- One week capstone project with other interns
- Changes for COVID:
 - Normally would travel for the training
 - Depending on the team/client could travel with them
 - Spend a few days in Disney at the end of the internship

Typical Day

- Varied every day depending on what needed to be done
 - 9-5
 - Touchpoint with team
 - interviews

- Global Student Experience Program
 - Work abroad for 4 weeks

My Project

- Within technology consulting I worked in the Data and Analytics subdivision
- Team of 6 people
- Client: large pharmaceutical company
- Trying to transition their analytics to be more advanced and eventually shift to AI
- Data strategy in very early stages
 - Map data landscape
 - Interview heads of the company to hear what analytics and reporting they are currently doing
 - Identifying pain points for the company to target
- Some projects would potentially code and involve more analysis

Applying

- My process for applying to the internship
 - Put in contact with a recruiter
 - Applied in August
 - Self recorded interview end of August
 - “Describe a time when...”
 - Super day in Chicago mid October before fall break
 - Networking session
 - 3 interviews
 - Fly home
 - Received an offer 2 weeks later and had 2 weeks to decide
- After the internship
 - Received a verbal offer the last week
 - Formal paperwork 2 weeks later
